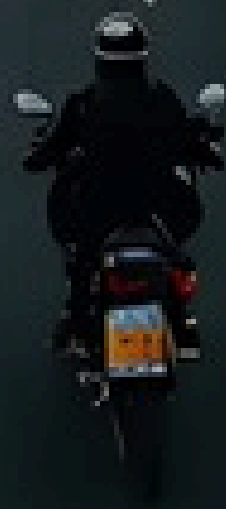
Trip Overview

- **Day 04:** Journey from Nubra Valley to Pangong Tso (14,000 ft | 160KM | 7-8 hr)
- **Day 05:** Journey from Pangong Tso to Leh via Chang La (11,600 ft | 160 KM | 5-6 hr)

Day 01

Arrival and Acclimatization in Leh

- Upon arrival in Leh, transfer to your hotel and spend the day at leisure.
- We recommend taking a gentle walk around your hotel to help your body acclimatize to the high altitude.
- Later, attend a detailed briefing about the journey and upcoming experiences.
- Enjoy a delicious dinner followed by an overnight stay in Leh.



Day 02

Leh to Nubra Valley | Crossing Khardung La

- Wake up to a refreshing morning and enjoy a hearty breakfast.
- Begin your journey towards Nubra Valley, a spectacular cold desert known for its unique landscapes and mountain ranges.
- Cross the thrilling Khardung La Pass, the world's second-highest motorable road.
- En route, visit the picturesque Diskit Monastery and admire the majestic Maitreya Buddha statue.
- Upon reaching Hunder, you may opt for a camel ride in the sand dunes (at additional cost).
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain for safety and coordination.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Nubra Valley.



Day 03

Nubra Valley to Turtuk Village to Nubra Valley

- Start your day with a delicious breakfast.
- Pack your bags and depart for Turtuk Village, which was part of Pakistan before 1971.
- Turtuk, nestled in the Nubra tehsil 205 km from Leh, sits along the banks of the Shyok River and is the last village before the LOC.
- Marvel at the breathtaking beauty of the valley, with views unlike anything you've seen before.
- After exploring Turtuk, return to Nubra Valley.
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain and relax with an overnight stay.
- Dinner, and overnight stay in Nubra Valley



Day 04

Nubra Valley to Pangong - Tso

- Start your day with a delicious breakfast.
- Gear up for another thrilling off-road adventure through the rugged mountain paths.
- Travel towards the stunning Pangong Tso (lake) via the Shyok River or the challenging Wari La Pass, a route often used by the army.
- Upon arrival, take in the mesmerising views of the blue waters of Pangong Tso.
- (*If Pangong Tso is closed, we will return to Leh and visit the lake the next day by SUV or tempo traveller).
- Enjoy the picturesque surroundings of the lake.
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain and settle in for the night.
- Enjoy dinner and overnight stay at Pangong Tso.



Day 05

Journey from Pangong Tso to Leh via Chang La

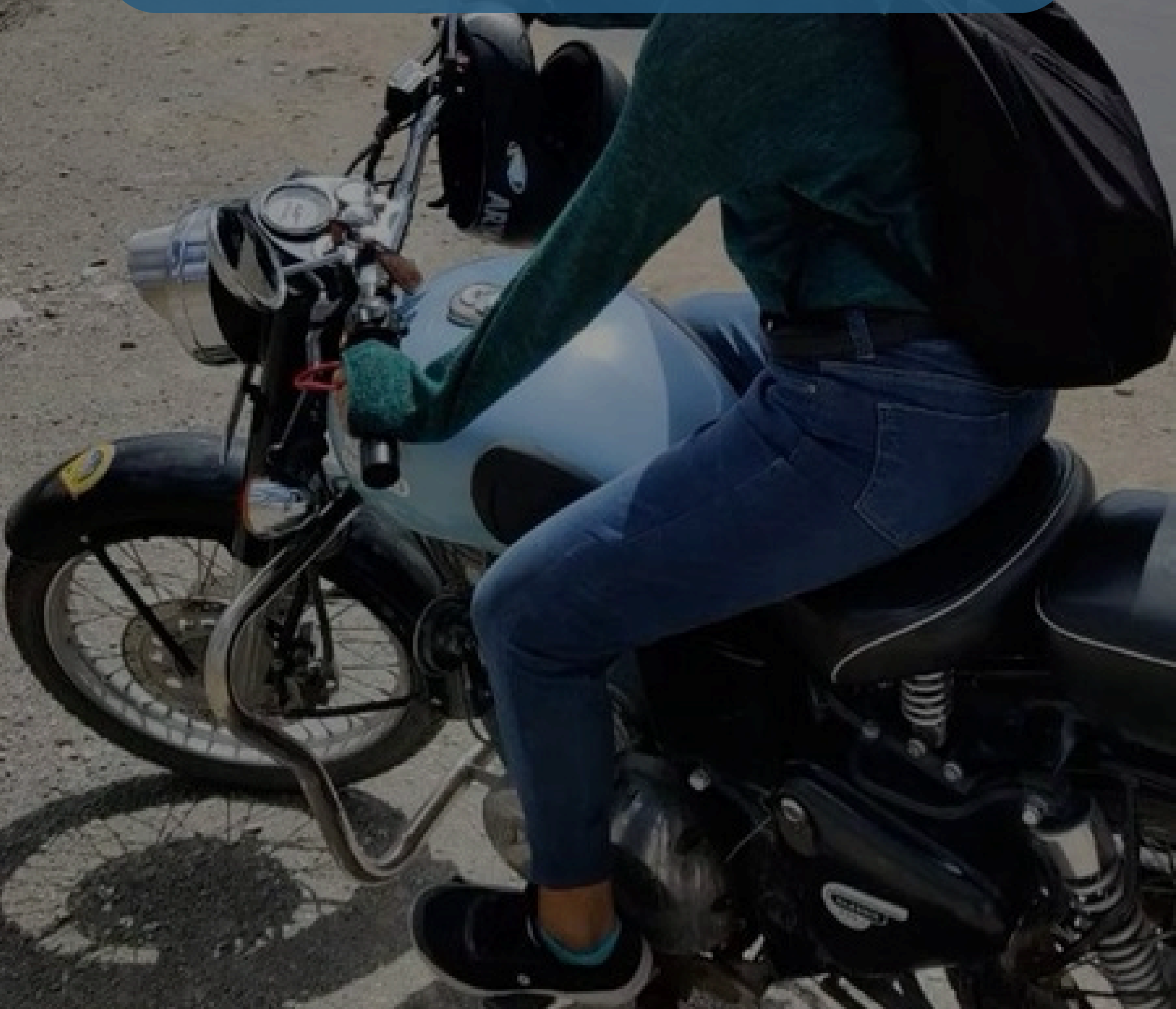
- Begin your day with a hearty breakfast.
- Get ready for an exhilarating ride back to Leh, passing through the scenic Chang La Pass, the third-highest mountain pass in the world.
- On the way, stop at the iconic Rancho School, made famous by the Bollywood movie '3 Idiots.'
- If time allows, visit the beautiful Thiksey Monasteries.
- Hand over your bike keys to the road captain and unwind for the night.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Leh.



Day 06

Departure from Leh | Journey Concludes

- After breakfast, proceed to the airport for your onward journey.
- Your memorable Ladakh adventure comes to an end.





Premium Inclusions

- Stay in pre-booked deluxe hotels on triple sharing in Leh.
- Enjoy a comfy stay in Swiss camps / Cottage with attached washrooms on triple sharing at Nubra Valley and Pangong Tso.
- The package includes elbow and knee guards, as well as a helmet.
- Savor buffet breakfast from Day 2 to Day 6 and buffet dinner from Day 1 to Day 5.
- Ride on 411 cc Royal Enfield bikes provided from the morning of Day 2 until the evening of Day 5.
- Receive bike permits and Inner Line Permits for all travelers.
- All necessary permits for the highest motorable passes in the world, including Khardung La & Chang La.
- Fuel will be provided according to the itinerary route.
- Benefit from the services of an experienced road captain and motorbike mechanic from Day 2 to Day 5.
- A first aid medical kit and oxygen cylinder will be provided with the road captain.
- A separate vehicle will carry luggage, limited to 1 rucksack/duffle bag of up to 60 liters per traveler.
- Receive an online certificate upon successful completion of the trip.



Exclusions

- Personal expenses such as telephone charges, laundry, tips, and table drinks.
- Any type of insurance, including medical, accidental, and theft coverage.
- Airfare or rail fare not mentioned in the "Inclusions."
- Pick-up or drop-off services at the airport, railway station, or bus stop.
- Costs for any spare parts needed due to accidental damage while the motorbike is in the rider's possession.
- Expenses for transferring or towing the motorbike, as well as servicing or maintenance costs if it is dropped on the way.
- Any lunches or meals not included in the package.
- A security deposit of ₹5,000 per motorbike for accidental damages or if the bike is left behind before the trip's end date.
- Parking, monastery, and monument entry fees during sightseeing.
- Costs incurred due to itinerary changes or extensions caused by natural calamities, roadblocks, vehicle breakdowns, union issues, or other factors beyond our control.
- Additional accommodation or food costs resulting from delays.
- Applicable GST.
- Any other expenses not mentioned in the inclusions.

Notes

- The check-in time is 12 noon/early check-in subject to availability of the room.
- We have the right to cancel the group if we do not get the minimum strength of bikes in any group.
- If there are any additional expenses due to bad weather or any other reason beyond the control of the tour operator on account of a hotel stay, transportation, and meals, etc. extra bill will be raised. Neither International Youth Club nor the participating partners/hotels will be responsible for the additional expenses.
- We are not responsible for any change in itinerary due to reasons beyond our control like change in flight and train schedule, cancellation of flights/trains, political disturbances, natural phenomenon, etc...
- If any group member wants to leave the group in-between the tour then he/she will not be eligible for any refund and has to pay the cost for transportation of bike from point of leaving the tour till the tour endpoint.
- Wearing a helmet, carrying a valid ID proof & Driving license is mandatory.
- All guests will be responsible for the safety and security of their own luggage. We will not be at all responsible for the damage / missing / lost luggage. So carry a small daypack bag to carry all the expensive things with you.

Notes

- Compensation for any damage/accident done by you during the tour to others property/person would be directly payable by you.
- Due to any unforeseen weather conditions, road blockage, snowfall, rain, storm, the tour may continue to operate in tempo traveler instead of bikes.
- Foreign Nationals have to pay separately on their own for the permits.
- Basic First Aid Kit – It's advised that one should bring his/her own medicines which are known and suitable to him.
- Road Captain will be responsible to manage the group by taking all safety measures. The group has to follow him to make the tour a success.
- We provide a well-experienced and skilled Royal Enfield Mechanic with spare parts and tools. They are well trained to handle large groups. The spares used on the way will be chargeable.
- Backing vehicle – Bolero/Camper/Xylo/Innova/tempo for mechanical and medical support.
- In case of an emergency, if any rider is feeling uneasy then he can sit in the backup.
- Only one rucksack/backpack of 60 liters will be adjusted as it will be having tools and spares too.



Trek Preparation & Safety Tips

- Stay fit — do light cardio & stretches before the trek
- Stay hydrated — keep sipping water
- Layer up — pack warm but light
- Invest in good trekking shoes with firm grip
- Carry basic first-aid & personal medicines
- Follow guide instructions — don't rush
- Respect nature — carry your waste back



Travel Essentials:

Gears

- Rucksack bag and a compact day pack
- 3-litre water bladder or refillable water bottle

Clothing

- Sun cap and woolen cap
- UV-protected sunglasses
- 1 cotton long-sleeve and 2 short-sleeve T-shirts
- 1 fleece jacket
- 1 thick / down jacket for extreme cold
- 1 pair of gloves
- Minimum 2 pairs of long pants (trek or cargo preferred)
- 6 sets of undergarments
- 6 pairs of socks
- Small travel towel
- Rain jacket or poncho

Footwear

- Above-the-ankle waterproof hiking boots with good grip
- Flip-flops or sandals for casual wear

Medication

- 1 strip of Diamox (for altitude adjustment)
- Glucose powder or energy mix
- Basic medicines for headache, diarrhoea, motion & altitude sickness
- Dettol, bandages, and cotton for first aid

Personal Accessories

- Toothpaste & toothbrush
- Paper soap or sanitizer
- Sunscreen (SPF 40+), lip balm & cold cream
- Body spray/deodorant
- LED torch light for nights or early morning walks

Visits depend on weather; alternate plans will be arranged if needed.

Weather, road, or health conditions may lead to minor itinerary changes. Adjustments will always be made for safety, comfort, and overall experience.

- The Luxury Trails reserves the right to modify or cancel the trip due to safety concerns or government advisories.

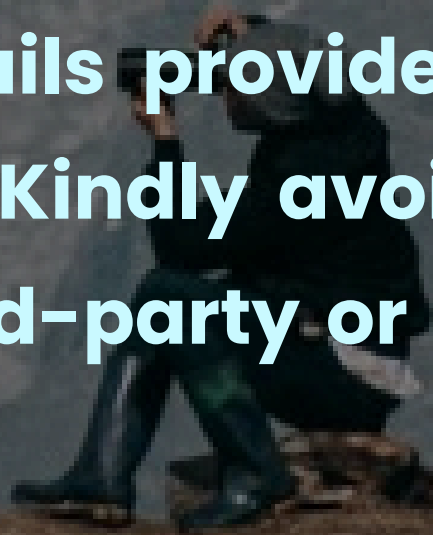
